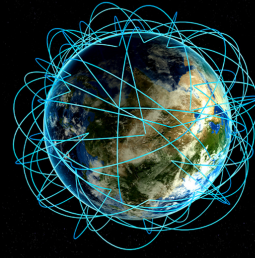

# EXETER STUDIES IN WORLD ORDERS



***Exeter Studies in World Orders* critically engages with the historical, political, economic, and cultural patterns of power that underpin the contested concept of ordering the international.**

The series provides space to explore the dynamics of the formation, preservation, transition, and dislocation of world orders.

Submissions could include the role of emerging powers, power transition, the function of international institutions, historical accounts of longer term trends, and novel interventions in debates concerned with a so-called liberal international order. Perspectives informed by the global south, or grounded in post-colonial, subaltern or feminist approaches are particularly welcomed.

Contributions are invited from the fields of international relations, international history, sociology, security studies, international political economy, foreign policy analysis, and cultural studies.

At its heart this series encourages interdisciplinary debate in order to foster productive reflection on the possible contours of new forms of global power balancing.
